**Proposal for Changes of MHRC Membership Chairman –
Responsibilities, duties etc.**

23 November 2009

Background

Currently, the Vice President of the Manassas Honda Riders Club (MHRC) performs the duties of the Membership chairman. The following proposal outlines recommendations and reasons for proposing to separate these duties.

Recommendations

- The Membership Chairman should be a position appointed by the MHRC President annually.
- The Membership Chairman will report to the Officers of MHRC, and make recommendations to the Officers regarding all membership policies, procedures, issues and actions.
- The MHRC Officers will vote to approve or reject the recommendations of the Membership Chairman.
- The Membership Chairman will maintain the membership records of MHRC.
- The Membership Chairman and the Secretary will maintain the monthly meeting sign-in records and will include the monthly meeting attendance into the meeting minutes.
- The Membership Chairman will collect annual dues. This will include annual renewal dues and new member dues. All money will be turned into the Treasurer for deposit into the MHRC Bank Account.
- The Membership Chairman will maintain the membership applications and records.
- The Membership Chairman will update the membership roster, and provide the roster and updates as necessary to the Officers, staff, and members upon request.
- The Membership Chairman will provide the membership roster to Manassas Honda, Kawasaki, Suzuki (MHKS) so that all paid members in good standing will be able to participate in the Purchase Discounts offered. Members not paid 30 days after the annual dues are due will be reported to MHKS as ineligible for discount benefits.
- The Membership Chairman will update the Newsletter Editor with the membership roster, including member email addresses so that all paid members in good standing will receive the monthly newsletter. Members not paid 30 days after the annual dues are due will not receive the monthly newsletter.
- The Membership Chairman will administer the Associate Member Policy.

MHRC Guidelines for Temporary Associate Membership for members experiencing financial difficulties

Date - 26 October 2009

Background -

From time to time, everyone experiences temporary, short term financial difficulties brought on by many external influences, often uncontrollable and unforeseen. Manassas Honda Riders Club (MHRC) is an organization of friends, fun, and fellowship for everyone who enjoys the activity of motorcycling and participating in an organization that enjoys helping others. Life events can cause financial strain and difficulties that may preclude our members from renewing their membership, association, and participation in activities and events of MHRC. To assist our current members to retain their full and active membership, association, and continued participation in events with MHRC during times of specific short term financial difficulties, the member body of MHRC desires to create a membership type of "**Temporary Associate Member.**"

Purpose and Procedure –

- Purpose of these guidelines is to create a new membership type called "Temporary Associate Member".
- This policy is created to ensure that all members are treated equally, fairly, and consistently as it regards to the Temporary Associate Member status and benefits.
- Temporary Associate Members will not have to pay their annual membership dues during the period of financial difficulty which is limited below.
- Temporary Associate members will not have to pay any activity fees that may be assessed by MHRC.
- MHRC Membership Chairman and the membership committee will review/renewal of eligibility of Temporary Associate Memberships.
- Temporary Associate memberships will be reviewed and renewed annually - in April of each year.
- Temporary Associate memberships will be limited to two full membership years (Initial year and one renewal year) per member, per incident.
- Temporary Associate members will retain all benefits and privileges of regular membership.

Eligibility –

- Current, paid up members of Manassas Honda Riders Club only are eligible.
- Members must be experiencing financial difficulties due to the following reasons:
 - Loss of employment
 - Death
 - Significant medical illness (e.g. cancer)
 - Extended hospitalization, hospice, respite, nursing care.
 - Significant physical injury or disability

Member Responsibilities –

- Affected Member must request Temporary Associate Member status to the Membership Chairman.
- Affected Member must request renewal of Associate Member status to the Membership Chairman.
- Member must terminate Associate Member status when financial difficulties are resolved and return to dues paying status.

Membership Responsibilities -

- Membership Chairman will recommend Associate Member status based specifically on the documented purpose, procedures, and eligibilities identified in this written document only.
- Membership Chairman will maintain confidentiality of the requesting members name and specific reason for Associate Member status request.
- Membership Chairman will report to the membership body of MHRC annually at the May monthly meeting the number of Associate Members being carried and the general reason for granting the Associate Membership status. (E.g. 3-Associate members, 2 for unemployment, 1 for significant medical illness.) This report will be entered into the permanent record of the meeting minutes.
